LEAD 100 is a flagship national initiative of Human Welfare Foundation (HWF) to identify, nurture and empower exceptionally talented students from underprivileged and backward communities, thus transforming them into competent, committed and socially aware leaders for tomorrow.

Over the first five years, 20 students will be selected each year. Beginning after Class X, selected scholars will receive residential education in Delhi during Classes XI & XII, followed by long-term academic and financial support through undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral studies.

Selection Process

A transparent, merit-based process designed to identify not only achievement, but also aptitude, character, leadership potential and the capacity to contribute meaningfully to society.

- Written Test** **10 October**
 Comprehensive assessment of academic potential, aptitude and broader competencies. Both MCQs and descriptive type of questions
- Interview** **17 - 18 October 2026**
 80 students shortlisted for the Selection Camp.
- Selection Camp** **14 - 15 November**
 Two-day residential assessment; 40 students shortlisted.
- Final Selection** **20 November**
 20 LEAD 100 Scholars selected on overall performance.
- School Admission** **20 November-31 March 31**
 Support for the school admission process.
