


Human Welfare Foundation






Capacity Building of **EXISTING SCHOOLS**

To rehabilitate ill-equipped schools by providing them with necessary funds to develop their basic minimum infrastructure.





Community **LEARNING CENTRES**



Community Learning Project-CLC is one of our promising projects. CLCs aim at imparting basic education to the out of school children in order to make them ready for formal education and providing coaching for dropout and school going children. After providing basic literacy and education, children are enrolled in nearby schools. These centres also provide vocational training to women and adults.

CLCs are set up in slums or slum-like places having 2-3 classrooms with adequate facilities. The education and training programs in CLCS include:

- Basic Literacy Program
- Adult Literacy Program
- Vocational Training
- Career Guidance & Counselling
- Nutrition Food Program
- Health & Hygiene
